1 Introduction

Volleyball Nations League Hong Kong 2026 (VNLHK) is an international sport event that attracts over 50,000 spectators and millions TV audiences in Hong Kong, Chinese Mainland and all over the world. The participation of China Women's Volleyball National Team and other national teams attracts attention from a lot of local and overseas media and results in plenty of news coverage. The tournament will be held on 8 – 12 July 2026 (From Wednesday to Sunday) at Kai Tak Arena with six national teams including Team China.

2 Objective:

Volleyball Association of Hong Kong, China (VBAHK) would like to invite qualified suppliers to respond to this tender invitation for Event Lighting and Audio System for the VNLHK 2026. This tender invitation sets out the requirements and the selection criteria to be used in the evaluation and provides information regarding how the tender process will be managed.

3 Interpretation

In this document, the following terms shall have the following meanings:

- 3.1 "Project" means the project described in Section 4;
- 3.2 "Tenderer" means the person(s) or corporation(s) tendering for the Project;
- 3.3 "Contract" means a formal agreement to be entered into between the VBAHK and the Contractor in relation to the Project containing such terms and conditions as the parties shall agree including (but not limited to) those terms set out in Section 11 hereof (unless the same shall have been modified by the VBAHK); and
- 3.4 "Contractor" means the Tenderer whose tender is accepted by the VBAHK.

4 Service Overview

(A) SPECIFICATIONS:

(I) Item

Rental Services of Event Lighting and Audio System at Kai Tak Arena for VNLHK 2026, including rental, technicians and operator (with no less than 8 years of stage management and production experience) standby services during the period from 29 June to 12 July 2026.

(II) Quantity Required

- (1) Setup and Dismantle services during the setup day on 29 June 2026 (TBC) AND dismantle day on 13 July 2026
- (2) Rental services of Event Lighting and Audio System with all accessories at Kai Tak Arena for VNLHK 2026
- (3) Technicians standby services during the period from 29 June to 12 July 2026
- (4) Operator standby services during rehearsal (2 days prior to competition period) and competition period (8 to 12 July 2026)

(III) General Requirements

(1) Arrange technician to check electric cables above the truss every night after the matches are finished

(2) Contractor requires to control the competition lighting at Kai Tak Arena in the same system.

(3) Contractor requires to design the lighting plan which additional lights MUST NOT block the default

competition lighting in Kai Tak Arena.

For other requirements, please refer to Annex A for detailed specifications for the event lighting and audio system

at Kai Tak Arena.

Please refer to Annex B for tentative working schedules.

The supplier must confirm whether the item meets the requirements listed in

(A)(III) by filling in the Annex corresponding to the specific item.

(B) QUOTATION

Quotation for the provision of Event Lighting and Audio System should include:

(1) All necessary costs of the supply, transportation, delivery, installation, certificates, insurance, testing and

commissioning, standby of technicians, immediate repair and replacement, dismantling from the supplier at Kai

Tak Arena;

(2) The unloading and custodial of material at Kai Tak Arena;

(3) Local taxes and customs charges;

(4) The prices quoted should be on unit basis;

(5) Supplier shall submit together with their tender offer the technical specification of the item required,

product catalog information, manufacturer's specifications for full and proper evaluation by tender

closing date 20 January 2026 at 5:00 p.m.; otherwise the tender will not be considered.

(6) Suppliers are requested to submit their offers in the Contract Schedule at Appendix I.

(C) DELIVERY OF SERVICE:

(1) Unless otherwise stated clearly by the contractor and accepted by VBAHK in writing, the price quoted must

include supply, shipping, local transportation fee and initial assembly, installation and dismantle of the loaned

item stipulated in the Specification of Annex A and B by the Delivery Location listed below.

(D) SUBMISSION OF TENDER

- (1) Service Providers are required to complete the following in the Tender Documents:
 - (a) Contract Schedule (Appendix I) (Rates for the Rental Services)
 - (b) Specifications of Event Lighting and Audio System at Kai Tak Arena (Annex A)

(E) REJECTION OF LOAN ITEMS

(1) The successful service provider is required to provide and maintain the Lighting and Audio units etc. on a free loan basis and must meet all specifications listed in Annex A during the rental period. Any loan items found to be of sub-standard quality and/ or poor workmanship upon delivery, installation or testing will be rejected and the Contractor will be notified either verbal or in writing by VBAHK. The Contractor shall replace all sub-standard units within (1) day from the date of notification.

(F) PRODUCT WARRANTY

The service provider shall guarantee all the Loan items supplied in Annex A against faulty workmanship, poor materials and defects for the period as specified in Annex A and repair due to manufacturing fault from the date of final acceptance of Goods by VBAHK. All materials, replacement parts, labour & transportation costs incurred during this period shall be borne by the supplier.

(G) Estimated of Probable Requirement

The quantity of the provision of standby technician in the tentative working schedule (Annex B) is an estimate of probable requirement only, the finalized working schedule will be provided a week before the event.

6 Guidelines for Tenderers on proposal submission

These guidelines are intended to provide Tenderers with guidance on the procedure for submitting their proposals and the approach that the VBAHK will generally adopt in assessing such proposals. They do not bind, and are not intended to bind, the VBAHK in any way. The VBAHK reserves the right to accept or reject all or any part of all or any proposal. The VBAHK is not bound to accept the lowest or any tender submitted.

6.1 Required components of tender proposal

- 6.1.1 Breakdown: Please refer to Appendix 1
- 6.1.2 <u>Previous Experience:</u> List any relevant experience your company has had in supplying to sport events.
- 6.1.3 <u>Key Benefits and Additional Services:</u> List any key benefits and / or additional services you can provide before / during / after event.
- 6.1.4 Delivery cost: Should your quotation included all delivery cost to any district and area.

6.1.5 <u>Long term Partner:</u> Please state if you would consider a cross-year partnership with special package offer.

6.2 Selection Criteria and Evaluation of Proposals (Listed in no particular order)

6.2.1 Cost of rental of event lighting and audio system

(While pricing is one of the considerations, the VBAHK will not make any selection based solely on price. So, the lowest of any tenders will not necessarily be accepted.)

- 6.2.2 Any additional service or significant items could be provided
- 6.2.3 Quality of production and services.
- 6.2.4 Past experience and good track record

The VBAHK reserves the right to shortlist the Tenderers, based on the above-mentioned criteria and only the shortlisted Tenderers shall be required to make presentations of their proposals for the VBAHK's final evaluation (if necessary).

6.3 Submitted form of tender

All proposals must be submitted in writing. Please submit the duly completed and signed tender proposals (hard copy) in a <u>sealed envelope</u> marked conspicuously "Confidential - Tender Document for Event Lighting and Audio System for Volleyball Nations League Hong Kong 2025" and deposit to the TENDER BOX at Unit 1111-1112, 11/F, Lu Plaza, 2 Wing Yip Street, Kwun Tong, Kowloon, Hong Kong <u>on or before 27 February 2026 17:00</u>. EMAIL submission is not accepted.

LATE SUBMISSION OR EMAIL WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED.

In case a rainstorm black warning or typhoon signal no. 8 or above is hoisted or remains hoisted between 9:00 am and 17:00 on the tender closing date, the tender closing time will be extended to 17:00 on the next working day following the affected closing date.

6.4 Validation period of Tenderer's offers

By making a proposal in response to this invitation to tender, the Tenderer will be treated as having made an offer to the VBAHK. Tenderers should keep their offers valid for <u>at least 6 months</u> from the closing date of this invitation to tender. The Tenderer should clearly state in its proposal for the tender validation period.

6.5 Queries regarding this invitation to tender or proposals made in response

- 6.5.1 If VBAHK considers that any aspect of a proposal requires clarification from the Tenderer, the VBAHK may request that the Tenderer to:
 - A. supplement its proposal; or
 - B. answer the VBAHK's queries verbally or in writing, or in any manner that the VBAHK deems fit.

7 Acceptance of proposal

No tender (or part thereof) shall be taken to have been accepted by the VBAHK unless and until the execution of the Contract by the VBAHK and the Contractor.

8 Rejection of proposal

The VBAHK retains the right to reject any or all tenders submitted for any reason whatsoever.

9 <u>Cancellation of Tender Invitation</u>

Without prejudice to the VBAHK's right to cancel the tender invitation at its absolute discretion or for public interest reasons, where there are changes of requirement after the Tender Closing Time for operational or whatever reasons, the VBAHK is not bound to accept any conforming tender and reserves the right to cancel the tender invitation.

10 Cost and expenses

All work done or services performed for the purposes of preparing the proposal are on the Tenderers' own account and not recoverable from the VBAHK. The VBAHK will not defray any expenses incurred in the tender process and/or in respect of the negotiation of the Contract.

11 Suspension, resumption or termination of Contract

11.1 The Contract may be suspended or terminated by the VBAHK at any time, by the VBAHK giving the Contractor written notice in letter or email.

- 11.2 On suspension or termination, the Contractor shall be paid all fees and expenses commensurate with the services performed by them up to the date of suspension or termination less all fees and expenses previously paid to the Contractor. The Contractor has the obligations to stop work immediately but in an orderly manner and do deliver to the VBAHK documents in its control relating to the Project. The VBAHK shall not be liable for any loss of profits and other losses incurred by the Contractor as a result of termination or suspension.
- 11.3 In the event of suspension or termination the Contractor shall be entitled to reimbursement of the actual cost of or an amount in fair compensation for any financial commitment or obligation outstanding after the giving of the notice of suspension or termination which he has properly incurred in accordance with the Contract prior to the giving of the notice of suspension or termination.
- 11.4 The payments referred to in sub-clauses (11.2) and (11.3) of this Clause shall be deemed in full and final payment for the Services up to the date of suspension or termination. The Contractor shall be entitled to such payments only if the suspension or termination is not attributable to default on the part of the Contractor.
- 11.5 If this Contract is resumed any payment of fees under this Clause except in respect of abortive work that has to be re-done shall rank as payment on account towards the fees payable under this Contract.
- 11.6 Should this Contract continue to be suspended for a period of more than 6 months then either:
 - (i) it shall be terminated upon the written notice of either party; or
 - (ii) it may be renegotiated with the Contract of both parties.
- 11.7 The Contractor shall use its best endeavours to perform the Contract with such due care and skill as is expected of a provider of similar services and products and of a comparable standing in the industry but if for whatever reason, the VBAHK in its opinion concludes that the Contractor is in breach of the Contract or does not provide the level of services required by the VBAHK, the VBAHK shall have the right to terminate the Contract by notice in writing to the Contractor.

12 Warning Clauses

12.1 The tenderer shall not and shall ensure that his agents and employees shall not give or offer any advantages as defined under the Prevention of Bribery Ordinance to any agent or employee of Volleyball Association of Hong Kong, China Limited, the "Association". The tenderer is also prohibited from colluding with other bidders in this tendering exercise in whatever forms (e.g. price

- rigging). Any breach of or non-compliance with these clauses by the tenderer shall, without affecting the tenderer's liability for such breach or non-compliance, invalidate his tender.
- 12.2 If the contractor or any employee or agent of the contractor shall be found to have committed an offence under the Prevention of Bribery Ordinance in relation to the tender or the contract, the Association may terminate the contract without entitling the contractor to any compensation therefore, and the contractor shall be liable for all losses and expenses necessarily incurred by the Association as the result of such termination of the contract.
